GUEST SERVICES

Guest Services is located at the front desk in the LEGOLAND* Hotel or the toll booth when you check in at the LEGOLAND* Beach Retreat.

LOW SENSORY AREA

Guests looking for a low sensory area, can head to Guest Services, the Florida Prepaid Schoolhouse (in DUPLO® Valley), or First Aid in the park or the water park.

QUIET ROOMS

Please ask one of our Model Citizens (employees) where the nearest quiet location is located. A private space in our Annual Pass Processing Center, near the theme park entrance turnstiles, includes hands-on, sensory-stimulating activities designed for children on the autism spectrum. Other quiet spaces include the First Aid location in Fun Town or at LEGOLAND® Florida Water Park by the Wave Pool, our Baby Care Center in the Florida Prepaid Schoolhouse, Imagination Zone and our Guest Services location.

RESTROOMS

There are several men's and women's restrooms facilities located throughout the Hotels, including inside the lobby areas and outside near the pool areas. Please ask a Model Citizen for the nearest restroom location. Companion restrooms are also available in select locations.

NOISE-REDUCING HEADPHONES

LEGOLAND* Florida Resort offers noise-reducing headphones to guests at Guest Services, the Florida Prepaid Schoolhouse (in DUPLO*), or First Aid in both the park and water park.

FIRST AID

Please contact the Front Desk, Guest Services or the nearest Model Citizen if you are in need of asistance. Other first aid facilities at the resort are located by the LEGO* Factory in LEGOLAND* Florida Resort Theme Park or by the Wave Pool at LEGOLAND* Florida Resort Water Park.

AMENITIES

PARKING

Parking is available at all three on-site Hotels. LEGOLAND* Hotel & Pirate Island Hotel's nightly resort fee includes self-parking. Valet parking is also available at LEGOLAND* Hotel. LEGOLAND* Beach Retreat's nightly resort fee includes self-parking.

DINING

BABY CARE

Baby Care is located within the DUPLO* area of the Resort. This facility is great for taking a break and includes private rooms for nursing mothers, baby changing areas, quiet rooms and a companion restroom.

FOOD POLICY

Outside coolers, food and beverages may be brought into the park under certain guidelines (see below). Alcohol may not be brought onto LEGOLAND* Florida property. Acceptable items:

- Bottled water
- Small snacks that do not require heating
- Any food required for medical purposes and medically-indicated nutritional supplements
- Any food required for special dietary needs
- Baby food/baby formula
- Soft-sided insulated bags no larger than 8.5" wide x 6" high x 6" deep
